As a team coordinator, your role may be to form an intervention team. In some cases, you will be working with a team that has already been formed. It depends on the nature of the situation. In any case, you need to know who the team consists of and what each member's role should be. Imagine a crisis situation (a situation in which there is imminent danger or involves death, threat, helplessness or strong negative emotions) such as a mass or big car accident, a natural disaster, a war conflict. Select one specific crisis and try to relate this situation to different professions, i.e., the specific persons who should be an essential part of the intervention team. For each profession/person, indicate which activity they should be invited to do as a part of the intervention team.

What should your team provide?

Who can help?

Whom should the assistance be provided to?

Why are individual members needed? What should their role be?
